A few weeks ago, I read Casey Cobb's post on Facebook. It triggered a flood of memories. I met Casey shortly after August of 1984 when at 13 he arrived at *Boys and Girls Country*. It's a place near Houston for "troubled youth." As Casey put it, "*I was developing into a little gangster at thirteen, and BGC was my last chance before going into the juvenile justice system.*"

At *Boys and Girls Country*, Casey found himself in the cabin of Willie and Mildred Hill. Suddenly, there was a house full of love, lots of rules and discipline, work, high expectations and a life based on wholesome, godly living. Momma and Daddy Hill showed how it's to be done; they were right in the middle of the lives of "*their boys:*" their schooling in Hockley, their homework, their schedule, what was going on in their lives and what was on their minds. Those boys ate like kings and went to church every Sunday. Momma Hill made sure every boy went through the *Basic Bible Truths* and knew exactly what it meant to personally know Jesus Christ as Savior. Momma Hill was not out for pretense; she wanted every boy to see the truth for himself.

I'm so happy to tell you that Casey's life turned around. And, we must! Many will never come to Christ. God gives every person a choice; and many will ignore the evidence, harden their hearts and say "No" to God; but not all. A few Casey Cobbs are still out there. God forbid that we fail to do all within our power to give every person an opportunity!

Is Atheism Dead?

This 412-page book consists of 30 powerful, overwhelming chapters. From the start, in an intellectual, scholarly, scientific and highly documented way, Eric Metaxes is on the offensive against atheism. He quickly establishes the great gap between true, objective science and the subjective, extremely radical and hate-filled bias of a large percentage of the scientific world, particularly many of its renowned leaders. With documented scientific fact after scientific fact, Mr. Metaxes exposes their known, provable lies. With a broad, scathing brush, he uncovers the clandestine, on-going efforts of atheists (multitudes of them popular, leading scientists such as Richard Dawkins) to eradicate from the human psyche all ideas and concepts of God in any form. They have had the wide backing of the academic community, the university system, the media/press and government. They have viciously attacked the Bible and Christianity (all religion and belief in God of any sort) as being an anti-intellectual, false and corrupting belief system unfit to exist or be tolerated among men.

Is Atheism Dead is presented in three parts. Part 1 is *Does Science Point to God?* The 8 chapters in this section present proven, objective scientific evidence which is almost universally accepted, even by the atheistic community. Metaxes appeals to Einstein, Newton, Sandage and Hubble. Contrary to the long-standing atheistic evolutionary stance which contends that matter has always existed, science has now proven that the Universe had a beginning-point. It has not always existed. Einstein saw it, but under intense pressure from the atheistic, evolutionary community, he buckled. Atheism had declared God dead, but Einstein's discovery undermined their premature conclusion. His and other evidence confirmed that the Universe continues to expand from a beginning-point. Undeniable intricacy and overwhelming evidence throughout the Universe confirms intelligent design. Metaxes presents an astounding parade of scientific proofs which continues to change brilliant, objective minds. Just one of many examples is the makeup and function of a single human "cell." The cell defies all odds of being an accident. A growing number of earth's most astute scientists are increasingly coming to the conclusion that the cell (and other phenomena) came into existence and continue to exist only at the hand of a creator. You owe it to yourself to go through Part 1 of *Is Atheism Dead?*

Part 2 is sub-titled *The Stones Will Cry Out*. This fascinating section consists of 10 chapters dealing with mostly recent archeological discoveries which confirm Bible claims. Scientific archeological digs, especially of the last 200 years, have repeatedly verified Bible claims which had been written off as spurious and figurative. For many "scholars" and scientific people, especially atheists, the Bible (and the God of the Bible), was summarily written-off as unscientific and unreliable, just a book of fables to be rejected and mocked. For well over 100 years, that picture has been steadily and rapidly changing. Without exception, long-rejected Bible claims have been validated. Biblical archeology has become a scientific discipline within itself, and the Bible is increasingly being viewed as the chief guide or map to the uncovering of factual information. As only a few of many, Metaxes points to The Black Obelisk, The Dead Sea Scrolls, Hezekiah's Tunnel, The Pilate Stone, The Pool of Siloam, The Nazareth Home of Jesus and the location of ancient Sodom and Gomorrah. The evidence is irrefutable, and has turned the atheist world on its heels. Needless to say, they do all they can to keep quiet and downplay all such evidence.

Part 3 is a 12 chapters expose of life in the atheistic world including the inevitable turmoil that rages in the atheistic mind. The atheistic stance is one completely void of purpose and hope. It flies in the face of overwhelming evidence. Atheism is a myth. Metaxes cites cases of atheists who have wrestled with the emptiness of their lives. A few have turned to God. Only God gives hope, and only the God of the Bible offers a plausible explanation for the existence of the Universe or a means of addressing the sin problem and hope beyond the grave.

"*Is Atheism Dead*" is a book for serious, mature thinkers and readers. It is not casual, flippant reading. The book will educate you, greatly expand your horizons and challenge you. It enriched me, and I highly recommend it.


